



Athletic Development Academy Terms and Conditions & Code of Conduct (2018)

1: Information and Data

(a) The information and data which is provided within your child's registration form will be held on the computers and manual records at the Athletic Development Academy [ADA].

2: Disclaimer

(a) ADA reserves the right to cancel any of its sessions or events at anytime, due to weather conditions and unforeseen circumstances, but will endeavour to notify parents as soon as possible via text message or email.

(b) All sessions and venues are subject to change according to venue availability, a satisfactory number of participants, and other factors beyond ADA's control. We may also change or cancel any programmes due to these factors.

(c) ADA's photographs and videos may be taken of registered participants on any of our sessions. These pictures and videos maybe used, reproduced and/or published in ADA's publications including magazines, news reports, sponsors and on our website and Facebook account.

(d) Although younger participants will be accompanied by a Parent/Guardian for the full duration of the sessions, you authorise ADA coaching staff to administer or approve any medical treatment deemed necessary to the participant, in your absence.

(e) ADA reserves the right to remove any disruptive participants or parents/guardians from its programmes and/or venue that may cause areas of concern for the ADA.

(f) Although ADA staff will take every precaution to prevent participants from injury or harm, the academy does not accept liability for medical expenses injuries that may be incurred during any of its programmes.

(g) Parents/guardians take full liability for their participants who may cause intentional damage to property and/or equipment of ADA or the venue in which the programmes take place. Participants who are found causing damage will be invoiced the cost of such damage and payment of such invoice must be made prior to attending the next session unless discussed with the Academy Director.

3: Conditions of Registration

(a) Confirmation of registration will be on receipt of the full registration fee and completed registration form. All registrations will need to be approved by an ADA Director at the start of each term or season.

4: Refunds

(a) There are **no refunds** once the participant has been registered and ADA has received payment, as this confirms their place within the programme.

5: Medical Conditions

(a) Parents/Caregivers are required to inform the ADA Director & Coach of any medical conditions, allergies and special needs your child may have.

6: Foreseeable risks or discomfort

(a) It is possible that participants may experience some mild muscle soreness due to unaccustomed exercise and activities related to football. Such mild muscle soreness (aching symptoms) may last for 2-3 days after participating in the programme. An appropriate warm up and cool down will be included in the sessions to reduce the likeliness of this occurring.

7: Code of Conduct

These Course Regulations form part of the terms and conditions of registration.

Parents/Guardians and participants agree that:

(a) All participants attending ADA will be accompanied by a parent/guardian or responsible caregiver for the full duration of the programme if 6 years or younger. Players need to arrive 5 minutes prior to the session, parents may leave but participants 7+ years old, but they will need to be picked up at the end of the session on time.

(b) All Parents/Guardians must demonstrate acceptable behaviours while attending ADA programmes. This includes no smoking, alcohol, and/or offensive language and/or behaviour.

(c) Parents/guardians must may be spectators at ADA but may not interfere, direct or coach children during trainings or games, while being supportive and respectful to ADA staff, participants and their families.

(d) Participants must comply with any additional rules and regulations that apply at any location where our programmes may be held and all instructions given from ADA staff.

(e) Participants must not bully, threaten or behave in a way that may be a danger to others during any of sessions.

(f) Players who demonstrate any ongoing behavioural issues may be suspended from the academy for a period deemed suitable by the ADA Director or coach.

(g) Participants must wear their ADA uniform, closed shoes during all programmes. All Children must provide their own water bottle.

These codes of conduct will be enforced by ADA. If a parent/guardian or participant fails to comply with this code of conduct, in whole or in part he or she may be removed from the academy without refund, as the safety and well-being of all participants is our priority.
